2026 Chinese Government Scholarship

"High-Level Postgraduate Program" Admission Brochure

The Chinese Government Scholarship "High-Level Postgraduate Program" is a full scholarship program funded by the Ministry of Education of China, designed for selected Chinese universities to independently recruit outstanding international students to study in China. This program aims to select international students with excellent academic backgrounds, professional capabilities, and development potential to pursue master's and doctoral degrees at our university. Based on the relevant documents from the Ministry of Education and considering the actual situation of the university, this brochure is specially formulated as follows.

I. Application Eligibility

1. Applicants must be foreign citizens with good moral character, physical and mental health, excellent academic performance, and a friendly attitude towards China. They must be able to consciously abide by the laws and regulations of the People's Republic of China, as well as the rules and disciplines of Kunming Medical University. Chinese citizens who have emigrated and apply to study at the

undergraduate level as international students must hold a valid foreign passport or nationality certificate for at least 4 years (inclusive), and have a record of actual residence abroad for more than 2 years in the past four years (as of April 30 of the enrollment year). Residence of at least 9 months in a year may be counted as one year, based on entry and exit stamps. Applicants meeting the above conditions must provide relevant supporting documents and undergo review by the university.

- 2. Educational background and age requirements for applicants:
 - Applicants for master's degree programs should hold a bachelor's degree or equivalent, have excellent academic performance, and generally be under 35 years old.
 - Applicants for doctoral degree programs should hold a master's degree or equivalent, have excellent academic performance, and generally be under 40 years old.
- 3. For applicants applying for master's or doctoral degree programs with Chinese as the medium of instruction, Chinese proficiency must reach HSK Level 4.
- 4. For applicants applying for professional degree master's or doctoral programs, Chinese proficiency must reach HSK Level 4.
- 5. Applicants must also meet the academic ability, language proficiency, and other relevant admission requirements of our

university.

II. Funding Information

1. Types of students funded:

Full-time master's and doctoral students.

2. Funding duration:

Master's students: 3 academic years; Doctoral students: 4 academic years.

- 3. Funding coverage:
 - (1) Tuition waiver.
 - (2) Accommodation fee waiver.
 - (3) Comprehensive medical insurance during the study period in China.
 - (4) Monthly living allowance during the study period in China:

Master's students: 3,000 RMB/month; Doctoral students: 3,500 RMB/month.

IV. Application Process

1. Applicants must log in to the "Chinese Government Scholarship

Information System" (website: https://campuschina.org) to register, fill in application information, and submit online. (The program category for the Chinese Government Scholarship "High-Level Postgraduate Program" is Type B, and Kunming Medical University's institution code is 10678).

- 2. Applicants must also log in to the "Kunming Medical University International Student Admission Platform" (website: http://study.kmmc.cn or https://kmmc.17gz.org/) to register online, complete the application, and upload application materials.
- 3. The information filled in and attachments uploaded in both systems must be accurate and consistent.

November 15, 2025 – December 31, 2025

VI. Application Materials

- Passport homepage. If the current passport's validity does not meet the requirements (passport validity should be later than December 2026), a new passport should be obtained before applying.
- Notarized highest education certificate. If the applicant is currently a student, a pre-graduation certificate issued by the school must be submitted. If the document is in a language other than English, a notarized English

translation must be provided.

- Academic transcripts (starting from the undergraduate stage). Scanned transcripts should include undergraduate, master's (if applicable), and doctoral (if applicable) stages, up to the most recent semester's grades. Transcripts should be issued and stamped by the academic affairs office, graduate school, or relevant student management department of the attended institution. Chinese/English transcripts may be provided; if in a language other than English, a notarized English translation must be provided.
- Language proficiency proof. Applicants applying for programs with Chinese as the medium of instruction must provide a valid HSK4 score report meeting the corresponding Chinese proficiency requirements. Applicants applying for programs with English as the medium of instruction should provide corresponding language proficiency proof as required by the university, such as IELTS or TOEFL score reports.
- *Note: Applicants for professional degree programs must provide HSK Level 4 or above proof. Those who do not provide HSK Level 4 or above proof will be processed as academic degree program applicants.
- Study plan in China. A study plan in Chinese/English (over 1000 words) must be submitted. For doctoral applicants, the study plan must be signed by a Chinese supervisor. The study plan can only be written in Chinese or English.

- Two recommendation letters from professors or associate professors from the previous stage of study.
- Foreigner Physical Examination Form and blood test report.
- Non-criminal record certificate.

Note:

- 1. Materials uploaded through the system must be clear, authentic, and valid. Applicants are advised to use professional equipment to scan the relevant documents. Consequences arising from unclear or unidentifiable uploaded materials shall be borne by the applicant. The university does not accept paper materials by mail.
- 2. Admission materials will be mailed to the address filled in under the "Email address" column in the application form. Please ensure the information is accurate. Admission materials will be provide in softcopies only, please print accordingly.
- 3. If the scholarship is awarded, the original copies of all the above materials (or the official graduation certificate for those who provided a pre-graduation certificate) must be brought for on-site verification during registration.
- 4. Our university has not authorized any individual or agency for the recruitment of Chinese Government Scholarship students. For matters related to scholarship applications, please contact our university directly. Do not trust any "guaranteed placement" or other

paid services offered by individuals or institutions.

VII. Admission Process

- 1. Applicants must log in to both the "Chinese Government Scholarship Information System" (website: https://campuschina.org) and the "Kunming Medical University International Student Admission Platform" (website: http://study.kmmc.cn or https://kmmc.17gz.org/) to register and fill in application information. (The program category for the Chinese Government Scholarship "High-Level Postgraduate Program" is Type B, and Kunming Medical University's institution code is 10678). The information filled in and attachments uploaded in both systems must be accurate and consistent.
- 2. Preliminary review: Our university will conduct a preliminary review of the information filled in and attachments uploaded by the applicant. The preliminary review results will only be provided through the "Kunming Medical University International Student Admission Platform" (website: http://study.kmmc.cn or https://kmmc.17gz.org/). Please ensure the email address filled in is accurate and valid.
- 3. Pre-admission: Applicants who pass the preliminary review will be matched with supervisors based on the principle of merit-based

selection and enter the online video interview stage. All interview notifications and online video interview methods will be communicated via email. Please check your email promptly to avoid missing the interview (missing the interview will be considered as the applicant voluntarily withdrawing).

- 4. Provisional admission: Applicants who pass the video interview will receive a supervisor's recommendation and obtain a pre-admission notice (scanned copy only, no hard copy). Please log in to the "Chinese Government Scholarship Information System" (website: https://campuschina.org) and upload it to the corresponding attachment field. Failure to upload by the deadline will be considered as voluntary withdrawal of qualification.
- 5. Admission: The China Scholarship Council (CSC) will conduct the final review. The university will inform applicants of the final results via email/WeChat, etc.

VIII. Others

1. Applicants shall pay timely attention to relevant documents and notices published by our university. All consequences arising from personal reasons such as negligence of the applicants shall be borne by the applicants themselves. The admission results for the Chinese Government Scholarship "High-Level Postgraduate Program" will

be directly notified to applicants via email. Applicants should regularly check their email and the university website for relevant information. Do not trust any "guaranteed placement" or other paid services offered by individuals or institutions.

- 2. Admitted students must bring the admission notice and materials required in the enrollment instructions to register at the university within the specified period. Those unable to register on time due to special reasons must submit a written request for leave with relevant proof materials to apply for deferred enrollment. The approved leave period generally should not exceed 15 days (calculated from the first day of the university's stipulated registration period). Those who do not request leave or exceed the leave period will be considered as having given up their admission qualification.
- 3. Scholarship recipients must participate in the annual scholarship review organized by the university. Those who do not participate or fail the review will have their scholarship suspended or canceled.
- 4. Chinese Government Scholarship recipients cannot simultaneously receive funding from other scholarships established by Chinese governments at all levels and the admitting university (excluding various one-time awards). If discovered, their Chinese Government Scholarship qualification will be canceled, and they must return the Chinese Government Scholarship funds already received. For those

who intentionally conceal funding situations, besides canceling their

qualification, they will not be allowed to apply for the Chinese

Government Scholarship for three years.
