I. Categories of Enrollment

Undergraduate, master's, and doctoral students in medicine-related majors.

III. Eligibility Requirements

1. Applicants must be foreign citizens with good moral character, physical and mental health, excellent academic performance, and a friendly attitude toward China. They must abide by the laws and regulations of the People's Republic of China and the rules of Kunming Medical University. Chinese citizens who have emigrated and apply as international students for undergraduate or college programs must hold a valid foreign passport or nationality certificate for at least four years (including) and have resided abroad for more than two years in the last four years (as of April 30 of the enrollment year). One year of actual

residence abroad is counted as nine months or more per year, based on entry and exit stamps. Applicants meeting these conditions must provide relevant proof and undergo university review.

2. Academic Background and Age Requirements

- Undergraduate Applicants: High school graduation or equivalent academic qualification, aged 18–25.
- Master's Applicants: Bachelor's degree or equivalent, with a major closely related to the applied program. For graduates from non-Chinese universities, the institution must be officially recognized by the Chinese Ministry of Education. Age: 18–35.
- Doctoral Applicants: Master's degree or equivalent, with a major closely related to the applied program or undergraduate major. For master's graduates from non-Chinese universities, the institution must be officially recognized by the Chinese Ministry of Education. Age: 20–45.

3. Language Proficiency Requirements

- Chinese-taught Programs: Ability to study in Chinese, with at least Level 4 of the "International Chinese Language Proficiency Standard" (HSK4).
- English-taught Programs: Strong English proficiency and solid foundational science knowledge. Non-native English speakers must provide IELTS Academic (minimum 6.0, no sub-score below 5.0),

TOEFL (Internet-based minimum 70, no sub-score below 15), or equivalent English test scores. Native English speakers or those with full English-medium secondary education may be exempt but must submit proof of English grades and medium of instruction from their secondary school.

4. China Scholastic Competency Assessment (CSCA)

Mathematics and Chemistry are mandatory subjects. All applicants of undergraduate programs must hold a valid "China Scholastic Competency Assessment (CSCA)" score report from within the past year. IV. Scholarship Information

1. Eligible Student Categories:

Full-time undergraduates, master's, and doctoral students.

2. Scholarship Duration (Covering the program's standard length):

Undergraduate: 4–6 years (depending on the major)

Master's: 3 years

Doctoral: 4 years

3. Scholarship Coverage:

- Tuition fee

- Accommodation fee
- Comprehensive medical insurance during study in China
- Monthly living stipend:

Undergraduate: 1,400 RMB/month

Master's: 1,700 RMB/month

Doctoral: 2,000 RMB/month

VI. Application Process

Applicants must apply online via the Kunming Medical University International Student Admission Platform: (<http://study.kmmc.cn> or <https://kmmc.17gz.org/>) Scholarship applicants should refer to the "Kunming Medical University 2026 International Student Scholarship Program Admission Brochure."

1. Required online application materials:

- Passport photo page (valid)
- "Foreigner Physical Examination Form" and blood test report
- Notarized highest diploma/degree certificate and academic transcripts (in Chinese or English)
- HSK Level 4 or above certificate (for Chinese-taught programs or

English-taught clinical medicine master's applicants).

- China Scholastic Competency Assessment (CSCA) score report (undergraduate program applicants must upload it, Mathematics and Chemistry are mandatory subjects. CSCA website: <https://csca.cn/>.)

- English proficiency certificate (for English-taught program applicants)

Resume and study plan.

- Two recommendation letters from professors or associate professors (required for graduate applicants) of previous school.

- Non-criminal record certificate

***Important:**

- Uploaded materials must be clear, authentic, and valid. Use professional scanning equipment; consequences of unclear or unidentifiable materials are the applicant's responsibility.

- The university does not accept paper materials by mail.

- Admission documents will be sent to the email address provided in the application form. Ensure accuracy. Only electronic admission documents are provided; print them yourself.

- Scholarship recipients must bring original documents for verification upon registration.

- The university does not authorize any individuals or agencies for Chinese Government Scholarship recruitment. Contact the university directly; do not trust any "guaranteed placement" paid services.

2. Review and Admission Process

The university will review application materials and conduct interviews for qualified candidates (interview notifications sent via email from official university email addresses ending in "@kmmu.edu.cn"). Admission is based on merit.

- Preliminary Review: The university reviews application information and attachments. Results are notified via the "Kunming Medical University International Student Admission Platform" (<http://study.kmmc.cn> or <https://kmmc.17gz.org/>). Ensure the provided email is accurate.

- Pre-admission: Qualified applicants proceed to online video interviews. Interview notifications and details are sent via email; check emails promptly to avoid missing interviews (missed interviews are considered withdrawal).

- Provisional Admission: Candidates passing the interview receive supervisor recommendations and enter the "provisional admission" stage. The university's expert committee reviews all provisional admissions and forms a recommended list based on merit.

- Final Admission: The recommended list is submitted to the Yunnan Provincial Department of Education for final approval. Final results are notified via email/WeChat.

VII. Registration

1. In line with the Chinese Ministry of Education's "paperless office" policy, the university issues electronic admission notices and JW202/JW201 forms via email only.
 - Admitted students must apply for an X1 visa within the specified time and register with all original application and admission materials.
 - Those unable to register on time must request leave in writing from Kunming Medical University in advance. Unregistered students without valid reasons will have their admission canceled.

VIII. Other Matters

1. Applicants should regularly check the university's official documents and notices. Consequences due to personal negligence are the applicant's responsibility. Scholarship results are notified via email; check emails and the college website for updates. Do not trust any "guaranteed placement" paid services.
2. Admitted students must register by the deadline with the admission notice and required materials. Those unable to register on time must request deferred admission in writing with supporting documents. Leave is generally limited to 15 days from the registration start date. Unexcused absence or overdue leave results in forfeiture of admission.
3. Scholarship recipients must participate in the annual scholarship review.

Those who do not participate or fail the review may have their scholarship suspended or canceled.

4. Yunnan Provincial Government Scholarship recipients cannot simultaneously receive other scholarships from Chinese governments or the university (excluding one-time awards). Violations result in scholarship cancellation and repayment of received funds. Deliberate concealment leads to disqualification and a three-year ban from applying for the Yunnan Provincial Government Scholarship.
